Registration Fee: \$20.00

Per family, non-refundable

(for swimming, students either bring money for the pool or provide a pool pass)

Rates: Full-time: \$155.00/wk.  
Daily: \$ 35.00/day

Part-time daily: \$ 25.00/day\*

\* Part-time not to exceed 5 hour/day

Payment due: Friday for following week

Meals: Children provide their own breakfast, lunch, and snacks.
